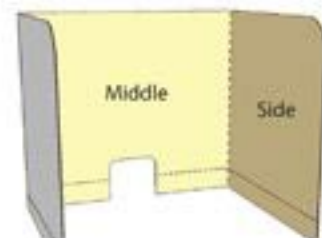
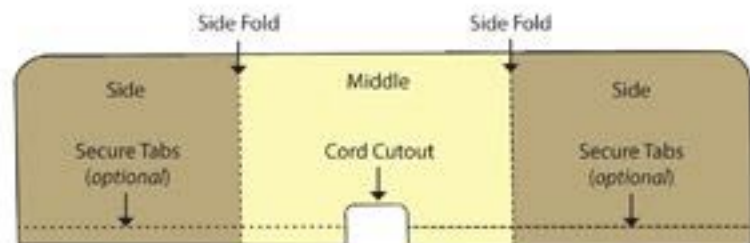


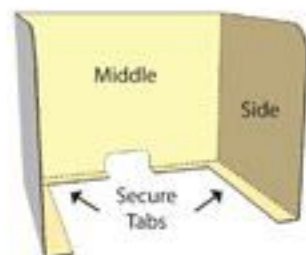
Computer Lab Privacy Screen Assembly Instructions



The Computer Lab Privacy Screen can be assembled four ways. Please review and decide which setup works best for you before folding the optional Secure Tabs. Dotted lines indicate scored folds. Consider keeping the shipping carton to protect the Screens when not in use.

Setup Option #1

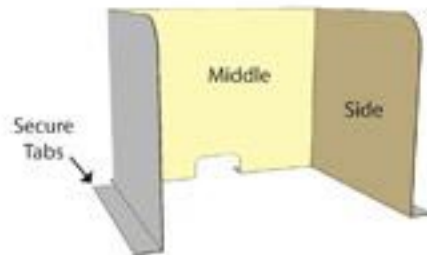
This setup is best if Screens will be set up and taken down frequently. Fold the sides in 90 degrees until they are perpendicular to the middle and parallel to each other.



Setup Option #2

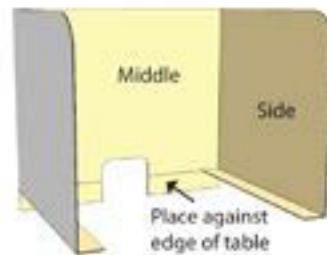
This setup works well when the Screens will be left in place permanently or rarely taken down. Fold the sides in 90 degrees until they are perpendicular to the middle and parallel to each other. Fold all Secure Tabs inward as shown.

Note: For permanent setup, glue the back corners where the back and side Secure Tabs meet. You may also wish to secure the Tabs with adhesive-backed hook and loop dots, allowing the Screens to be easily disassembled and stored flat. (Glue or Dots not included.)



Setup Option #3

This setup is best when linking the Screens together permanently or frequently. Fold the sides in 90 degrees. Fold all Secure Tabs outward as shown. Note: For permanent setup, overlap and glue the side Tabs together. You may wish to secure the side Tabs with adhesive-backed hook and loop dots allowing the Screens to be easily disassembled and stored flat. (Glue or Dots not included.)



Setup Option #4

This setup is best when using the Screens frequently. Fold the sides in 90 degrees. Fold only the side Secure Tabs inward as shown, placing the back tab over the back edge of the table. You may wish to secure the back Tabs to the table edge with adhesive-backed hook and loop dots allowing the Screens to be easily disassembled and stored flat. (Dots not included.)
